From Faithful Friar Father Ed Littelmann

What a time to be coping with life, health, confusion, weather extremes, pandemic, politics, leadership, supporting one another, worship in common and individual and how it will all work out......

I think I could fill the whole column with a continued list, but I want to share a precious moment I experienced this last week when I was asked to give a talk to our deacons on their annual retreat. My topic was "how to identify with Jesus and the Holy Spirit."

We started with considering that Jesus, even though He is divine, also is a human being and had to learn all about life from that point of view in a way that we could identify with Him and trust His word. By twelve years old when taken to Jerusalem by Mary and Joseph and finding Himself alone in the Temple, He became aware that God is His FATHER in a special way. Then next He admitted that He should be baptized by John even though He was not aware of any sin. He allowed that and had the experience of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit come upon Him. Then He spent 40 days fasting in the desert and encountered Satan personally who tempted Him to be successful by handing over His role and purpose in life to Satan. With that He recognized what was going on and began His role as teacher of the whole world at the hand of His Father recognizing He would be guided by their Holy Spirit. John's Gospel reflects a lot of these truths.

A fantastic truth from our religion is that WE can share the same dwelling of the Holy Spirit when we are baptized and place ourselves in His hands as we recognize ourselves as His instruments in our own generation. We just need to keep on growing in grace all our lives. And we have special gifts in the support systems we experience from being in a faith-filled family, a parish, a diocese, the Knights of Columbus and all the others each of us gets to witness to with one another as instruments of the Holy Spirit.

I got to share a number of my own personal faith experiences during that retreat talk. And you have heard some parts of my story, but having had this experience so recently, I'm interested in opportunities to help Knights continue to learn also as I can share my stories with you (some of which I already have over the years), and we can become even better apostles and brothers and sisters as our world enfolds with some new wrinkles and ways to teach like streaming and zoom. 


