With the month of March beginning, we're in crazy weather a lot more lately, but Lent is a bulwark with its precious emphasis on prayer and fasting with God as our Best Friend and definite Protector. That's a good life motive to concentrate on, growing in so that we have important confidence for all the rest of the calendar year! 


