To My Precious Brothers and Sisters this Holy Week and Easter Season,

It's been quite a year that's had my mind going in a thousand directions pretty regularly..... In preparation for this Holy Week beginning with Palm Sunday so quickly, I've been opening up (as I daily always do) to the Holy Spirit for what I can share with us Knights' families who are such an important part of my spiritual life. With my current experiences of so often seeing fewer and fewer Catholics at Masses, I've been pondering what I can personally do to make a difference and then be able to share those ideas with a lot of people in my life. Here's my story (which I think I've shared a few times already!)

Way back in seminary days (late 50's + early 60's) my dad with whom I worked a lot as a marble contractor was a Knight of Columbus and bowled every Wednesday evening with the Knights. That impressed me a bunch and I started bowling too as I became a Knight. That's before I was ordained a priest (May 1969), I felt like I really belonged! The Knights have been a wonderfully significant part of my life and priesthood all these years and still running (as you all know).

We Knights with our families are more than just a fellowship. Fr. McGivney added that significant dimension to our lives of faith to be able to attract more and more young men to Catholicism by being able to be a mission of providers to those who have lost solicitude. We are a great example of what it means to be an instrument in the hands of the Lord = disciples. Our world needs us just as much (and even MORE) than ever. The BEST factor of our wonderful organization is to be sharers of our faith in the Source of who we are. We need to get better at telling our stories (to, with and for one another!

A recent example in my life happened a week or so ago when I was hearing Confessions at St. Martin de Porres parish here in Toledo. After our Confessions were finished, Sr Ginny Welsh, OSF/T invited me to join a bunch of people who were just enjoying snacks together before we all left for home. In that experience I was introduced to a second grader who was there with a foster mom sitting across and down the table. We were enjoying the moments. And he wondered if he could possibly be a priest. I told him him "you sure can, God loves you and needs you." I then shared with him (and whomever else was listening) that when I was in second grade, our priest told us in the classroom that we should all work hard on being our best selves and NOT wind up going to hell. My thoughts at that moment were that I would become a priest, and I shared that with my classmates at Blessed Sacrament school all the rest of my six years there till Fr. Mueller got me into the seminary (Josephinum) where he was ordained.

That's one of my stories I've told several times. (Not that whole thing, just the last two sentences.) Let's all help each and one another share our faith experiences to get ourselves more-closer to Jesus. Holy Week is a great chance to get a good new start and have Easter be FANTASTIC all the rest of our wonderful lives. OK?


